PowerSchool Parent Logon

PowerSchool now has a combined parent logon which allows you to create one account with a username and password of your choosing, and attach each of your children to your account. This account will give you access to your child's schedule, teacher e-mail address(es), and attendance information. NEW! It will also serve as the launch point for other systems, such as Athletics registration (coming soon), School Registration (coming soon), and SchoolMessenger Contact Preferences.

Step 1. Visit <https://ps.sau8.org>

Step 2. Click the "Create Account" tab.

Step 3. Create your Parent Account. Complete your first and last name (not your child's), your email address, and then select a username and password that works for you.

Under the Link Students to Account section, you will need the **Access ID** and **Access Password** for each of your children – this can be obtained from your child(ren)'s school. If you wish to start with just one child, the system will allow you to add in other children later.
